

#### Challenge 4: Host a school-wide Zero Waste Day (2 credits)

A Zero Waste Day is exactly what it sounds like: a day where your school produces literally no waste. Others have done it before, and your school can be next! To prepare for it, there are few tasks your Green Team should get done before the big day:

- A) Market the event through posters, school announcement, and faculty emails
- B) Create **activities** for the whole school to participate in
- C) Encourage cafeteria staff to not offer wrapped food items, such as fruit snacks and granola bars. [Learn](#) about other ways to produce zero waste in the cafeteria.
- D) Encourage teachers to not use paper

To complete these tasks while engaging in distance learning, teachers are encouraged to guide their students through an at home zero waste day. Students can pack lunches without using trash, reduce their trash production and try using internet based learning tools instead of paper based.

To receive credit for this challenge, your semester report will have to include:

2 activities your school performed for Zero Waste Day

Marketing material for the event that was distributed across the school (i.e. fliers, faculty email)

Pictures from your event (optional)

If done virtually: submit marketing materials, a summary of activities students participated in as well as photos from several different students.

P.S. We know one of the hyperlinks leads to activities for Zero Waste *Week*. However, we do not require that you do these activities for a week, although you're free to go the extra mile if you wish.
