

### **Challenge 3: Create a student recycling club (2 Credits)**

Establishing a student recycling/environmental club can be a huge step in getting students to become involved in a school's waste reduction efforts. To complete this challenge, the club must have at least five students and accomplish two activities in one semester related to recycling or waste reduction. Here are some possible activities for a recycling club at the [elementary school level](#), [middle school level](#), and [high school level](#), although we're open to other ideas as well. You can also qualify for this challenge if you have another philanthropy club (i.e. Key Club) that is performing recycling-related activities. To complete this challenge, your semester report will have to include:

- 3 meeting notes with meeting dates and items discussed
- 2 recycling club activities included in your semester summary
